- 5. Submit verification of minimum scaled scores on the Test of English as a Foreign Language internet- Based Test (TOEFL iBT) of 79 or, if seeking certification, 24 for speaking, 22 for listening, 22 for reading, and 21 for writing or International English Language Testing System (IELTS) to evidence English language proficiency if your undergraduate or graduate degree was not earned at an accredited institution of higher education in the United States or at an institution of higher education in a country outside of the United States as listed <u>http://ritter.tea.state.tx.us/sbecrules/ tac/chapter230/19_0230_0011-1.pdf</u>
- 6. Complete the College of Education application if seeking certification.
- 7. Submit the FERPA Form if seeking certification.
- 8. Submit the Code of Ethics Form if seeking certification.
